History Moment: On April 1, 1938, the Nestle Company introduced a new powdered instant coffee – Nescafe. Pushed to develop a new coffee product to use a glut of coffee beans in Brazil following the Great Depression, it became an instant hit. Over 2/3 of Nescafe produced during WWII went to US troops.
