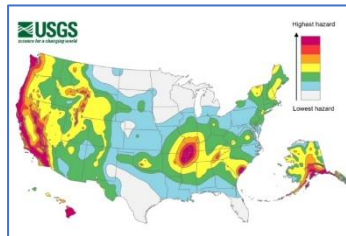

History Moment: On April 28, 1988, Aloha Airlines Flight 243, a Boeing 737-200 enroute from Hilo, on the Big Island of Hawaii, to Honolulu, lost an 18-foot section from the top of the fuselage. The depressurization swept one flight attendant out of the aircraft, the incident's only fatality. The passengers in the open section suffered from hypoxia since they did not have access to oxygen, but all survived. The pilot ultimately safely landed the aircraft 13 minutes later in Maui.
